## Anotācija

Tiešsaistes ziņu virsrakstiem jārosina auditorijas vēlme izlasīt rakstu. Lasītāja uzmanību var piesaistīt ar mākslinieciskās izteiksmes līdzekļiem. Šo līdzekļu un virsrakstu saikne pētīta maz, tāpēc darbā aplūkoti mākslinieciskās izteiksmes līdzekļi *lsm.lv* virsrakstu angļu un latviešu valodas versijās. Pētījuma mērķis bija noteikt, kuri mākslinieciskās izteiksmes līdzekļi atrodami tiešsaistes sabiedriskā medija *lsm.lv* ziņu virsrakstos angļiski un latviski, kā arī noskaidrot to tematisko dalījumu. Pētījumā izmantota sistemātiska literatūras izpēte, kontentanalīze un biežuma analīze. Noskaidrots, ka *lsm.lv* virsrakstu angļu valodas versijā mākslinieciskās izteiksmes līdzekļi izmantoti daudz biežāk nekā latviešu valodas versijā. Daži izteiksmes līdzekļi sastopami biežāk, citi netika atrasti nemaz. Novērots, ka tematiskais sadalījums valodās atšķiras. Lai jomu aplūkotu pilnīgāk, iespējams to pētīt tālāk.

## **Abstract**

News headlines online aim to entice the audience into reading the article. Stylistic devices in online news headlines are an effective means to attract the reader's attention. Research regarding news headlines and stylistic devices is scarce. Therefore, a study on lexical and phonetic stylistic devices in Latvian and English online news headlines was conducted. The goal of the paper was to determine what lexical and phonetic stylistic devices are used in the news headlines of the Latvian and English language versions of the online public service medium *lsm.lv*, as well as their distribution across news topics. The research was carried out through a systematic literature review, frequency analysis, and content analysis. The study found that the English headlines of *lsm.lv* use significantly more lexical and phonetic stylistic devices than the Latvian version. Certain devices were present more frequently, whereas others were absent. It was found that topic distribution differs between the two languages. Further studies may be carried out to generate a more complete analysis of the field.

# Introduction

Consumption of online media has steadily increased over the past decades. With the ongoing globalisation process, it has become more important than ever to render news available to a broad audience of diverse backgrounds and different languages. Therefore, online news plays a vital role in providing information flow to the public.

Latvian scientific community has not yet widely addressed online media language. Dominece-Diasa (2009) has studied the language of printed Latvian media; Bernāne (2009) looks at the language of printed and online advertising in Latvia. A study on online news translation has been conducted in Lithuania (Petronienė and Žvirblytė, 2012), comparing English headlines on various news platforms to their Lithuanian equivalents.

News headlines are the first and often the only piece of information the reader comes across; therefore, it is vital that the headline is not only informative but also attention-grabbing. Mass communication nowadays has an important role in forming societal viewpoints and attitudes towards certain events, topics, and personalities; hence, the way content is worded is as crucial, if not even more important, as the content itself. Mass media texts, including news headlines, are therefore likely to display stylistically saturated language aiming to captivate the audience and possibly influence their opinion on a certain topic.

Because of the high possibility of news headlines playing a part in directing people's thinking, it is important to investigate language patterns in these texts. One way to render a text attention-grabbing, persuasive, and influential, is by using stylistic devices. This study aims to explore what stylistic devices are used in the headlines of the Latvian public service media platform *lsm.lv* and its English-language counterpart *eng.lsm.lv*, how frequently they are used and what topics they are attributed to. Because a public service medium, according to Public Media Alliance (2020), should be impartial, unbiased, and credible, it is important to explore whether the language used in headlines contribute to these factors. The study can be later used as grounds for further research in other fields, such as sociology or psychology, to determine how effective the stylistic patterns are in attracting the audience's attention and/or impacting their opinions and attitudes.

The goal of the paper is to determine the frequency of lexical and phonetic stylistic devices and their distribution across news topics in the English and Latvian headlines on the Latvian public media news platform *lsm.lv*.

To achieve the goal, the following research questions have been proposed:

1. What are the features and characteristics of the language of online news headlines?
2. What characteristics and functions do stylistic devices have?
3. Which lexical and phonetic stylistic devices can be found in the Latvian and English headlines of the public service medium *lsm.lv*?
4. What is the distribution of stylistic devices in the headlines across different news topics in Latvian and English?

To answer the questions, enabling objectives have been introduced:

1. To characterise the language of online news media and headlines;
2. To study and present theory on stylistic devices;
3. To find out the absolute frequency of each stylistic device in the *lsm.lv* news headlines in Latvian and English;
4. To identify the distribution of stylistic devices across news topics in both languages;
5. To compare the frequency of stylistic devices and their distribution across topics in Latvian and English headlines.

The theoretical and empirical research methods employed in this study are:

1. Systematic literature review (Okoli and Schabram, 2010)
2. Frequency analysis (Leech and Short, 2007)
3. Content analysis (Krippendorff, 2004; Bazerman and Prior, 2004).

The study is based mainly on stylistics theory and classification of stylistic devices as proposed by Galperin (1977); the analysis is carried out based on frequency analysis patterns as defined by Leech and Short (2007) and content analysis as defined by Krippendorff (2003). The corpus of texts used in this study are 635 online news headlines in English and the corresponding 635 headlines in Latvian, published on the Latvian public service media website *lsm.lv* between March 1, 2019 and March 1, 2020. The data was collected by manually selecting headlines in the selected time period, sorting them into tables, analysing their content, and generating statistics and graphs using Microsoft Excel.

The thesis consists of an introduction, 3 chapters, 10 subchapters, conclusions, and one appendix. The first chapter explains the notion of style and stylistics, and characterises the language of news and news headlines. The second chapter describes and classifies stylistic devices, characterises each stylistic device, compiles a list of their functions and relation to news

headlines. The third chapter describes the corpus, methodology, tools, and analyses the data obtained in the study.

# 1. The Language of Online News

## 1.1. Style and Stylistics

News articles can be said to be one of the most widespread forms of communication, as the modern lifestyle demands constant flow of information. The headline, the first and often the only part of the news piece being read, occurs not as a separate entity but dependent on broader discourse. Therefore, in order to analyse news headlines, the style of news texts must first be described, starting with the notion of literary style, and stylistics as a science.

According to Crystal and Davy (1969), style may refer to a variety of meanings: “a selection of language habits which characterise an individual’s uniqueness”; “language habits shared by a group of people at one time or over a period of time”; or it can be given “a more restricted meaning when it is used in an evaluative sense, referring to the effectiveness of a mode of expression” (10). In other words, style can be attributed to the unique language choices of an individual, or distinctive patterns of choices belonging to a group. Galperin (1977) states that “style is a set of characteristics by which we distinguish one author from another or members of one subclass from members of other subclasses” (11). Chloupek and Nekvapil (1993) refer to style as “an integrative principle of the use, choice, or modification and composition, of formative elements” (57). Leech and Short (2007) state that it refers to “the way in which language is used in a given context, by a given person, for a given purpose” (9). From these different approaches, one may conclude that style refers to certain language peculiarities which distinguish one entity from another, for example, news headlines will have a different set of linguistic characteristics than a formal letter.

The science dealing with style is called stylistics. The aim of stylistics is “to analyse language habits with the main purpose of identifying those features which are restricted to certain kinds of social context” (Crystal and Davy, 1969: 11). According to Leech and Short (2007), literary stylistics has the goal of “explaining the relation between language and artistic function” and “the critic’s concern of aesthetic appreciation and the linguist’s concern of linguistic description” (11). However, stylistics can also be used to achieve other goals, depending on the purpose and choice of the researcher. In this study, a quantitative approach to stylistics is used to characterise the language of news headlines in the Latvian and English versions of the public media website *lsm.lv*.

Historically, stylistics branch out in formalist and functionalist (functional) stylistics (Burke, 2014). This study deals with functional stylistics, which is concerned “with the ways in which formal properties of language are used pragmatically” (Halliday, 1994, cited in Burke, 2014: 43); thus, the context where language is used is important. This study looks at the peculiarities of language use in news headlines with additional context: the news stories are published on the Latvian online public service medium *lsm.lv* and its English language counterpart *en.lsm.lv*. Hence, the audiences to these media differ. It is curious to find out whether the same medium in different languages differs in style.

## **1.2. Newspaper style**

The language of news, from the viewpoint of functional stylistics, is referred to as the newspaper functional style. Due to it being the last one of distinguished functional styles, it is also referred to by some scholars as publicist/journalist style/register. The main functions of the newspaper style are “infomatory and propagatory” (Chloupek and Nekvapil, 1993: 113), expressed in a way to convince and make the audience aware of the communicated content. Biber and Conrad (2009) state that the style must follow the requirements of ‘novelty and relevance’ (113). In other words, news texts should be informative, fresh, topical, persuasive, and accurate.

These characteristics require a practical linguistic way of expressing them, which is why the language of newspaper texts, over time, has established set linguistic features, such as evaluative adjectives, journalistic cliches, stylistic devices, phraseological units, etc. (Galperin, 1977; McNair, 2009; Petroniene and Žvirblyte, 2012).

The headline, however, is a “separate study” in itself (Crystal and Davy, 1969: 180). Due to the fast-paced lifestyle most people lead, the headline, especially in online news, must be concise, attention-attracting, and convey the main message in a way that the audience need not even read the article. Headlines should contain a “clear, succinct and if possible intriguing message; to kindle a spark of interest in the potential reader” (Crystal and Davy, 1969: 174).

News articles online are constructed as “inverted pyramids”, which means that the most important information is provided at the beginning of the text - especially the headline (Rich, 2009: 263). A study has suggested that the first three words in headlines are the most important to attract Web readers (Rich, 2009: 255).

Therefore, scholars have identified general guidelines and characteristics concerning the vocabulary and syntax of English headlines in order to save space, provide accurate facts, and summarise the intended message (Galperin, 1977; Saxena, 2004; Rich, 2009):

- the vocabulary should be simple and specific;
- articles should be omitted;
- present tense is most commonly used;
- punctuation is avoided;
- numbers are written as numerals;
- strong verbs should be used;
- long words should be replaced by shorter;
- the most important words should be placed first;
- interrogative headlines should be used if the subject is enticing enough, etc.

However, concise factual content is not enough to create an effective headline. The headline aims to entice the audience into reading the article. A crucial aspect is the emotional tone, which can effectively be achieved through stylistic devices.

## 2. Stylistic devices

### 2.1. Definition and classification

Over time, scholars have used various terms to denote linguistic means by which language units can be made “more conspicuous” (Galperin, 1977: 24): Corbett (1971) refers to them as “figures of speech”, Galperin (1977) calls them “stylistic devices”, whereas Grinnell (1987) uses the term “wordplay”. Corbett’s definition is rather broad: “a form of speech artfully varied from common usage” (1971: 460). Galperin (1977) defines a stylistic device as “a conscious and intentional intensification of some typical structural and/or semantic property of a language unit (neutral or expressive) promoted to a generalized status and thus becoming a generative model” (29). From these definitions, it can be said that stylistic devices are language units that are varied in a non-literal sense, thus creating an artful effect, and the ways these variations are achieved can be classified according to their properties. Classifications by different scholars vary slightly. The present study uses Galperin’s term “stylistic device” and the classification provided by him.

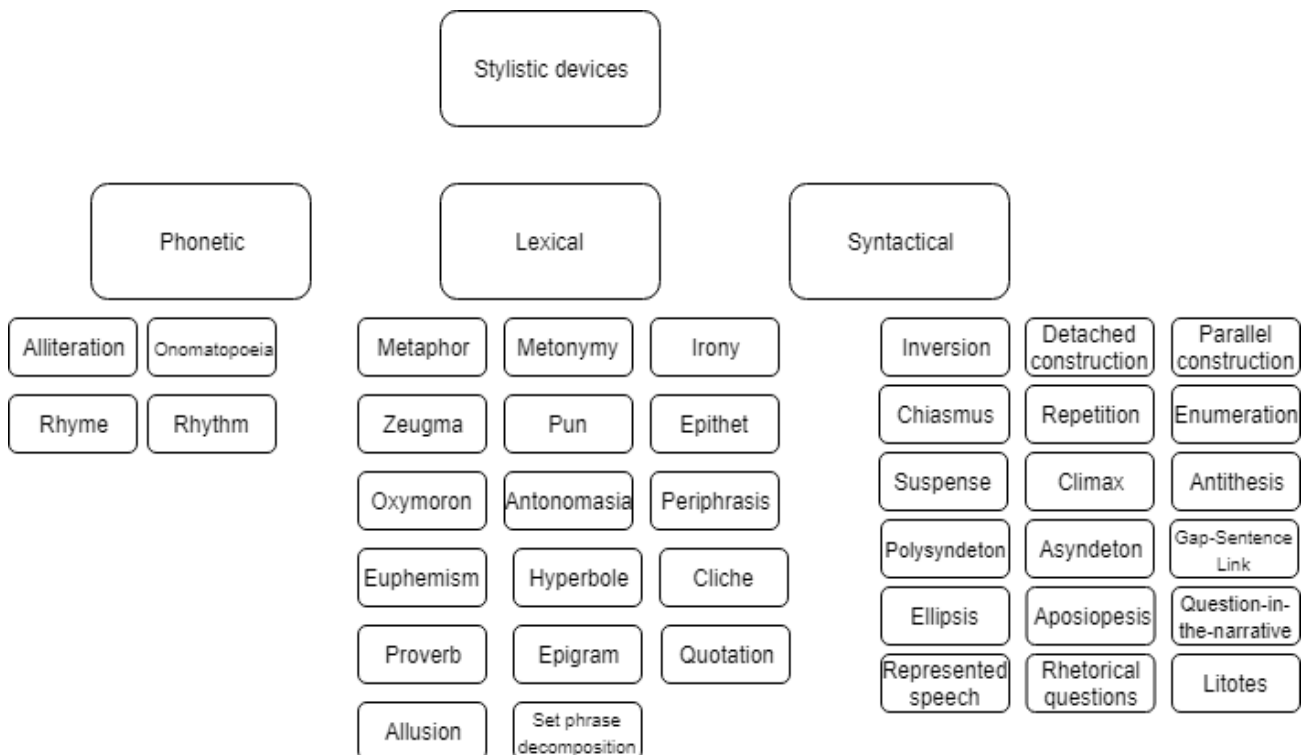


Figure 2.1. Galperin’s classification of stylistic devices. (Adapted from Galperin, 1977)

As seen in the scheme above, Galperin (1977) distinguishes phonetic, lexical and syntactical stylistic devices. For the purposes of this study, only phonetic and lexical stylistic

devices are taken into account. Given that the headline is a short, detached syntactical construction with set peculiarities, certain syntactical devices are very unlikely to be found, e.g., parallel construction or chiasmus, which are typically bound to larger structures (Galperin, 1977: 207), whereas others, such as ellipsis, is nearly a must (Rich, 2009). Furthermore, the differences in Latvian and English syntax would make the task too broad for the scope of this study, and the results could turn out unreliable or meaningless. Therefore, the thesis deals only with lexical and phonetic stylistic devices as classified by Galperin.

In the following subchapters, a brief description of each lexical and phonetic stylistic device is provided.

## **2.2. Lexical Stylistic Devices**

A lexical stylistic device, based on the general definitions of stylistic devices provided above, could be defined as an artfully varied form or intensification of a language unit on the lexical level, i.e., relating to words and the vocabulary (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1003). Galperin (1977) distinguishes lexical stylistic devices as follows: metaphor, metonymy, irony, zeugma, pun, epithet, oxymoron, antonomasia periphrasis, euphemism, hyperbole, cliché, proverb, epigram quotation, allusion, and set phrase decomposition.

### **2.2.1. Metaphor**

Metaphor is “a figure of speech in which a word or phrase is applied to an object or action to which it is not literally applicable” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1112). Metaphor implies a comparison of things that are unlike, transference of quality from one object (or linguistic unit) to another (Galperin, 1977: 138; Arp and Perrine, 2013: 28). Because it is rather a matter of identification and not comparison, Galperin defines metaphor as “the power of realizing two lexical meanings simultaneously” (1977: p. 139). Lakoff and Johnson (2003) argue that, while metaphor is commonly thought to be a matter of “extraordinary rather than ordinary language” (4), it is actually present in people’s everyday language, thoughts, and actions. Metaphors which are unexpected and unique are called “genuine” metaphors (e.g. *raindrops fall joyfully*), whereas those commonly used in speech and fixed in dictionaries are called “dead” or “trite” (e.g. *a shadow of smile*) (Galperin, 1977: 140).

### **2.2.2. Metonymy**

Metonymy is defined in the Oxford Dictionary of English (2010) as “the substitution of the name of an attribute or an adjunct for that of the thing meant, for example, *suit* for *business executive*”

(1114). Metonymy is based on association between two concepts related in meaning; one entity is replaced by another (Lakoff and Johnsen, 2003: 35). Some metonymies, such as *crown* for *king* or *queen*, are easily predictable; others, however, require additional context, for instance, when someone is referred to by his/her looks. These unpredictable metonymies are called “genuine” and are used in language-in-action, depending on context (Galperin, 1977: p. 144). According to Lakoff and Johnsen (2003), a subtype of metonymy where a part of an entity stands for a larger entity, e.g., *wheels* for *a vehicle*, is called a synecdoche (36).

### **2.2.3. Irony**

Oxford Dictionary of English (2010) defines irony as “the expression of one’s meaning by using language that normally signifies the opposite, typically for humorous or empathic effect” (924). For example, “It was so clever of him to get a cat when he is allergic!” It is clear that the sentence expresses mockery instead of appraisal. A word or phrase used ironically may express humour, irritation, displeasure, pity, or regret (Galperin, 1977: p. 146). Irony, alongside exaggeration, understatement, etc., is a technique to say “one thing but mean something else” (Lakoff and Johnsen, 2003: 207).

### **2.2.4. Zeugma**

A zeugma is “a figure of speech in which a word applies to two others in different senses, e.g., *John wore blue jeans and a grin*” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 2065). The words are normally adjacent in context, one carrying the literal meaning, the other - transferred meaning (Galperin, 1977: 149).

### **2.2.5. Pun**

Pun, like zeugma, plays with several meanings of words and phrases, but is freer in form. Oxford Dictionary of English (2010) defines pun as “a joke exploiting the different possible meanings of a word or the fact that there are words which sound alike but have different meanings” (1439). Galperin mentions the title of Oscar Wilde’s play “The Importance of Being Earnest”, where the name of the main character and the adjective interact (p. 150). A pun can be similar to metaphor in the sense that it “points to a coalescence of concepts normally distinct” (Leech and Short, 2007: 112), but it does so in a way that creates a humorous effect.

### **2.2.6. Epithet**

An epithet is “an adjective or phrase expressing a quality or attribute regarded as characteristic of the person or thing mentioned” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 590). It is based on the interplay of “emotive and logical meaning” (Galperin, 1977: 157) and is “subjective and evaluative” (ibid.), which distinguishes it from logical, objective attributes, such as *green grass*. Galperin distinguishes between speech epithets and language epithets, respectively, those created by the author anew (such as *sleepless bay*) and those that have become traditional and predictable (such as *sweet perfume*) (ibid.)

### **2.2.7. Oxymoron**

Oxymoron is defined as “a figure of speech in which apparently contradictory terms appear in conjunction, e.g., *honest lies*” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1271). Oxymoron is most common as an *adjective + noun* combination, though it can also be expressed through other structures (Galperin, 1977: 162).

### **2.2.8. Antonomasia**

Antonomasia is “the substitution of an epithet or title for a proper name, e.g., *the Maid of Orleans* for Joan of Arc” or “the use of a proper name to express a general idea, e.g., *a Scrooge* for a miser” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 70). Thus, antonomasia simultaneously employs two meanings of a word or phrase, the nominal and the logical. It is intended to “point out the leading, most characteristic feature of a person or event” via using this feature as a proper name (Galperin, 1977: 164).

### **2.2.9. Simile**

Simile is defined as “a figure of speech involving the comparison of one thing with another thing of a different kind, used to make a description more empathic or vivid” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1662). According to Galperin, the difference between a simple comparison and a simile lies within the fact that a simile only brings out one feature that can be attributed to the two compared objects, thus they are characterized in unexpected light (166). To exemplify, *a boy is as tall as his sister* is a comparison, whereas *thoughts shot in like bullets* is a simile. In simile the comparison is “expressed by the use of some word or phrase, such as *like, as, than, similar to, resembles, or seems*” (Arp and Perrine, 2013: 28), thus, it has a defined structure.

### **2.2.10. Periphrasis**

Periphrasis, according to the Oxford Dictionary of English, is “the use of indirect and circumlocutory speech or writing” (1322). It entails longer phrasing in place of a possible shorter one. It, however, functions as a stylistic device only in occasions when it requires context to be understood; otherwise, it is a synonymic expression, also called “traditional, language, or dictionary periphrasis” (Galperin, 1977: 169). Examples of dictionary periphrases are *a play of swords* denoting a battle or *the fair sex* for a woman. Galperin exemplifies genuine/speech periphrasis (i.e., one that requires context) with a Dickens quotation “my son (..) deprived of what can never be replaced”. *What can never be replaced* in this case refers to mother, whereas in other situations it can be interpreted as something else (ibid.)

### **2.2.11. Euphemism**

Oxford Dictionary of English (2010) defines euphemism as “a mild or indirect word or expression substituted for one considered to be too harsh or blunt when referring to something unpleasant or embarrassing” (603). In a way, euphemism can be viewed as a subtype of periphrasis, as it also involves circumlocutory phrasing. However, its purpose is more specific: to soften a blunt concept, to produce a “deliberately mild effect” (Galperin, 1977: 172). It is commonly employed to refer to taboo subjects as “markers of politeness” (Leech and Short, 2007: 251), e.g., it is typical to use expressions like *pass away* or *depart* instead of *die*.

### **2.2.12. Hyperbole**

Hyperbole is “an exaggerated statement or claim not meant to be taken literally” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 861). Like many other stylistic devices, hyperbole, when used frequently, can establish itself in language, like *scared to death* or *light years away*. Galperin (1977) claims that hyperbole is deliberate and meant to be understood as an exaggeration (176), thus allowing the reader to make a logical assessment of the real extent of the attribute.

### **2.2.13. Cliche**

A cliché is a “phrase or opinion that is overused and betrays a lack of original thought” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 325), an “expression that has become hackneyed and trite” (Galperin, 1977: 176). Cliches, though, depend greatly on subjective perception, because “what is trite to one person may still be fresh to another” (Altick, 1956, quoted in Galperin, 1977).

Cliches, according to Galperin, might both sound bothersome and provide a feeling of familiarity.

#### **2.2.14. Proverbs and Sayings**

Proverbs are “short, well-known pithy sayings, stating a general truth or piece of advice (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1429). Proverbs are established in language both in form and meaning, but they can also “extend” the meaning of the context” (Galperin, 1977: p. 180). Common proverbs are *Home is where the heart is* or *Out of sight, out of mind*. Often, they will rhyme or repeat (ibid.) For emphasis, proverbs can be altered to fit the context and draw special attention to their features.

#### **2.2.15. Epigrams**

Epigrams are “pithy sayings or remarks expressing an idea in a clever and amusing way” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 589). The definition looks to be the same as that of a proverb, but the difference lies within the fact that the author of an epigram is known, which is not the case with the proverb. They also have a “literary-bookish” air to them (Galperin, 1977: 183).

#### **2.2.16. Quotation**

A quotation is “a group of words taken from a text or speech and repeated by someone other than the original author or speaker” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1459). Unlike epigrams, quotations do not have to be short. Usually, a reference is given when quotations are employed. Quotations are normally used to illustrate or prove what is said (Galperin, 1977: 185).

#### **2.2.17. Allusion**

An allusion is “an expression designed to call something to mind without mentioning it explicitly, an indirect or passing reference” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 55). The reference can be made to a well-known fact, an event, a literary work, the Bible etc; allusion presupposes the reader’s knowledge or awareness of the fact, as it is only implied and not stated directly (Galperin, 1977: 186). According to Arp and Perrine (2013), an allusion is “a means of suggesting far more than it says” (53), as it makes the reader think and make the connection on their own (ibid.) Allusions can produce a witty and humorous effect, as well as be powerful and emotional (ibid.)

#### **2.2.18. Decomposition of set phrases**

According to Galperin, decomposition of set phrases occurs when a phrase established in form is altered in structure. This causes the reader to be presented with parts of the unit, giving it a new meaning (Galperin, 1977: 189).

### **2.3. Phonetic stylistic devices**

Phonetic stylistic devices are artfully varied, intensified features of language that “relate to speech sounds” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1433). Galperin (1977) states that the effect of these features is achieved when words are used in combinations with other words, not as separate units (122). Whereas lexical stylistic devices can bring a new meaning to words and phrases, phonetic stylistic devices are mainly used for aesthetic purposes (ibid.)

#### **2.3.1. Onomatopoeia**

Onomatopoeia is defined in the Oxford Dictionary of English as “the formation of a word from a sound associated with what is named (e.g., *cuckoo*, *sizzle*)” (1241). According to Galperin (1977), onomatopoeia can be likened to metonymy in that it represents an entity substituted by another (123). He distinguished two types of onomatopoeia: direct and indirect, respectively, pure imitation of natural sounds (e.g., *meow*, *ping-pong*) and something requiring mention of what makes the sound (e.g. *rustling*) (ibid.) Nevertheless, onomatopoeia possesses a direct connection between a sound and a phenomenon (Leech and Short, 2007: 37).

#### **2.3.2. Alliteration**

Alliteration, according to Oxford Dictionary of English, is “the occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of adjacent or closely connected words” (43). Galperin (1977) states that alliteration regards consonant sounds in particular (125); however, Arp and Perrine (2013) distinguish between consonance (repetition of consonant sounds) and assonance (repetition of vowel sounds) (72). Alliteration produces a musical effect to reinforce the author’s idea and creates a “vague emotional atmosphere” based on the sound that is repeated and the associated phenomena (Galperin, 1977: 125)

#### **2.3.3. Rhyme**

Rhyme is defined as “correspondence of sound between words or the endings of words, especially when these are used at the ends of lines of poetry” (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1525). Rhyme, according to Galperin, can be full or incomplete. Full rhyme repeats a vowel sound and the following consonant sounds in a stressed syllable (*mail – fail*); incomplete rhyme may repeat only the vowel (*flesh-press*) or the consonant (*flung-long*) (127). In poetry,

there are other ways to distinguish different types of rhyme, such as end rhyme or internal rhyme (Arp and Perrine, 2013); however, for the purposes of this study, these are not relevant.

#### **2.3.4. Rhythm**

Rhythm, in linguistics, is “the measured flow of words or phrases in verse or prose as determined by the relation of long and short or stressed and unstressed syllables (Oxford Dictionary of English, 2010: 1525.) Rhythm is the “main factor which brings order into the utterance” (Galperin, 1977: 128). Rhythm demands alternation of contrasting segments of speech (ibid.) – long and short or stressed and unstressed syllables; it has been claimed that rhythm can be perceived when there are deviations from it (ibid.) Rhythm is easier to perceive in poetry, whereas in prose it can be more difficult to grasp (Leech and Short, 2007: 96).

#### **2.4. Functions of stylistic devices**

From the definitions and characteristics of stylistic devices described by scholars referred to (Crystal and Davy, 1969; Galperin, 1977; Lakoff and Johnsen, 2003; Leech and Short, 2007; Arp and Perrine, 2013), it is possible to outline a general (not exhaustive) list of the main functions stylistic devices perform:

- create associations between different notions and concepts
- bring humor and wit into discourse (especially pun, zeugma, irony)
- make the reader critically evaluate the presented content (especially irony, oxymoron, hyperbole)
- reinforce the author’s intended message/attitude
- soften otherwise harsh concepts (especially euphemism, periphrasis)
- illustrate or support an idea
- create an artistic feel to the text
- evoke emotions
- create a sense of familiarity and relatability (especially trite metaphor, speech epithet, cliché).

These functions, if skillfully woven into news headlines, might very well trigger emotion in the reader and direct their thoughts and attitude to the desired effect – or, on the contrary, make the audience think and evaluate the presented content critically and logically, depending on the device and context.

## 2.5. Stylistic devices in relation to news headlines

News headlines, just like any other type of text, are more likely to contain certain features and not contain others, including more and less typical stylistic devices that may be found in headlines. Because the news headline is an entity dependent on a news article or story, i.e., a text representing the newspaper style, which in turn has been derived from publicist style (Galperin, 1977; Burke, 2014), stylistic devices in headlines presumably co-occur with peculiarities of these styles to some extent, depending on the purpose and nature of the text. For instance, Galperin (1977) states that both publicist and newspaper style generally achieve the emotional appeal by making use of stylistic devices; however, the stylistic devices “are not fresh, or genuine” (286). This statement leads to think that headlines might contain, for instance, more trite metaphors than genuine, or more language epithets than speech epithets. Galperin also states that the headline in particular is likely to employ deliberate breaking up or fusing of set expressions, as well as puns, alliterations, onomatopoeias (303).

A study on stylistic devices in English online news headlines was conducted in 2016, which found that metonymy and metaphor were commonly used in headlines; however, this study also took into account syntactic devices and was based on a slightly different classification (Monsefi, 2016). Other than that, no comprehensive studies could be found regarding this topic. Leigh (1994) analysed stylistic devices in print ad headlines; other headline analyses only mention stylistic devices in passing (Petroniene and Žvirblyte, 2012; Wu, 2017).

Because research regarding this topic is scarce, this study looks at how the stylistic devices in English and Latvian headlines of *lsm.lv* compare to Galperin’s claims (1977) and Monsefi’s study (2016), previous findings, as well as proposes new speculations based on the results of the study.

### 3. Empirical Research

#### 3.1. Methodology

Leech and Short (2007) claim that investigation of style is mainly concerned not with stylistic choices in isolation, but rather patterns of choices (34); this statement applies to the current study, as it investigates frequency of stylistic devices and the distribution pattern across news topics. According to Leech and Short, to find out what is distinctive of a corpus, one should “work out the frequencies of the features it contains and then measure these figures against equivalent figures which are ‘normal’ for the language in question” (35). The scholars further state (36) that it is nearly impossible to compile an exhaustive list of linguistic features of a text, Because the topic of headlines in connection to stylistic devices has not been researched to the extent of establishing a “norm”, this study is limited in the possibilities of determining deviations or co-occurrences. Furthermore, this study explores two languages, which might display different patterns.

Here, it is worth mentioning the “relative norm” (Leech and Short, 2007: 41). The authors state that mere accounts of frequency are unreliable and “vacuous” unless there is a comparison to something outside the corpus. As mentioned, prior studies of stylistic devices in English news headlines are few and far between; in Latvian, none are available. Therefore, this study primarily focuses on comparison of the device patterns in the two languages: essentially, comparing the linguistic choices in two versions of the same online medium. According to Leech and Short, “the narrower the range of comparison, the surer we are that the stylistic features we are attributing to [a corpus] are peculiar to [this corpus], rather than to the style of a larger category of writings” (43). This applies to the current case: because of the narrow range of comparison, the results should clearly depict the style of the medium *lsm.lv* in Latvian and English.

Regarding practical aspects of “measuring” style, Leech and Short (2007) mention linguistic categories (52). In this case, linguistic categories are the stylistic devices: metaphor, metonymy, alliteration, and so on. Occurrence of a linguistic category “entails the non-occurrence of other categories” (Leech and Short, 2007: 52). To work out the frequency of a particular feature or category, one figures out the number of times it occurs per a standard measure (Leech and Short, 2007: 53). Moreover, it is preferable to carry out measurement of a feature in relation to the “immediately superordinate category” (ibid.) In this study, multiple such measurements are carried out:

- the frequency of headlines containing a stylistic device in comparison to the total number of headlines (in English and Latvian separately);
- the frequency of headlines containing a stylistic device per topic (in English and Latvian separately).
- the frequency of each stylistic device per topic (in English and Latvian separately).

Leech and Short (2007) further mention an alternative method of frequency measurement, i.e., the ratio of a feature in comparison to another (ibid.) In the present study, this method applies to the following measurements:

- the frequency of each stylistic device in English as compared to the same device in Latvian;
- the frequency of headlines containing a stylistic device per topic in English as compared to the same topic in Latvian.

The methodology selected for the analysis regarding stylistic devices across topics is content analysis. Klaus Krippendorff (2004) has defined contemporary content analysis as involving these distinguishing features: content analysis “is an empirically grounded method, exploratory in process, and predictive or inferential in intent;” “transcends traditional notions of symbols, contents, and intents;” “has been forced to develop a methodology of its own” (Krippendorff, 2004). Bazerman and Prior (2004) have defined content analysis as ‘the identifying, quantifying, and analyzing of specific words, phrases, concepts, or other observable semantic data in a text or body of texts with the aim of uncovering some underlying thematic or rhetorical pattern[...].’ (Bazerman and Prior, 2004: 14).

### **3.1.1. Corpus description**

The corpus of the study was news headlines of the Latvian online public service medium *lsm.lv*. Public service media, according to the Public Media Alliance (2020), refers to “a shared multi-platform media space that is relevant, credible and impartial”. The same source states that public media should generate content that is high-quality, appealing and entertaining to a broad and diverse audience.

The selected headlines were published on the website between March 1, 2019 and March 1, 2020. The headlines were collected in both Latvian and English; because there is a greater amount of content published in Latvian, only the headlines which had a counterpart in English were included. A total of 635 headlines in each language were collected. The headlines were sorted in topics based on the topic classification in the English version of *lsm.lv*, namely, politics

(including diplomacy, election, President, Saeima, politics); society (incl. Latvians abroad, education, crime, health, defense, society); culture (incl. history, art, literature, theater, culture, sport, food and drink); economy (incl. transport, banks, employment, business, economy); weather (incl. environment).

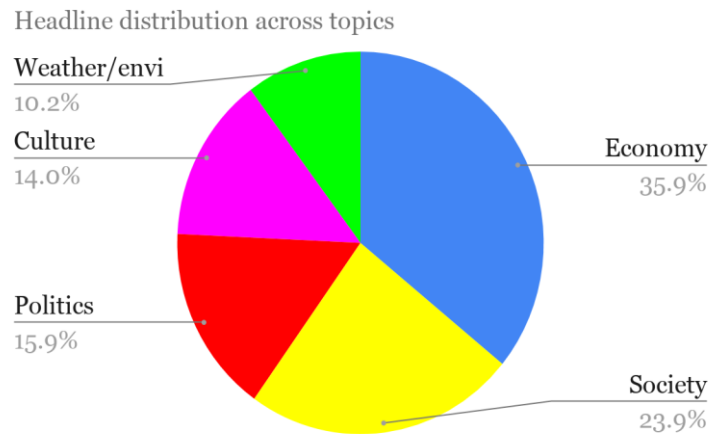
As seen in the screenshot above, *lsm.lv* also provides a category named Features; however, since it is not a topic per se but rather a format, it was not included in the study and the news articles falling in this category were sorted according to the topic they represented.

### 3.1.2. Data collection process and tools

The tools used in this study extended only to the use of Microsoft Office Word and Excel. First, all corresponding English and Latvian headlines published on *lsm.lv* in the chosen time period were compiled in a table. Then, they were color-coded according to topic, and the headlines containing a stylistic device were sorted in categories. All the necessary calculations and graphs were made using MS Excel.

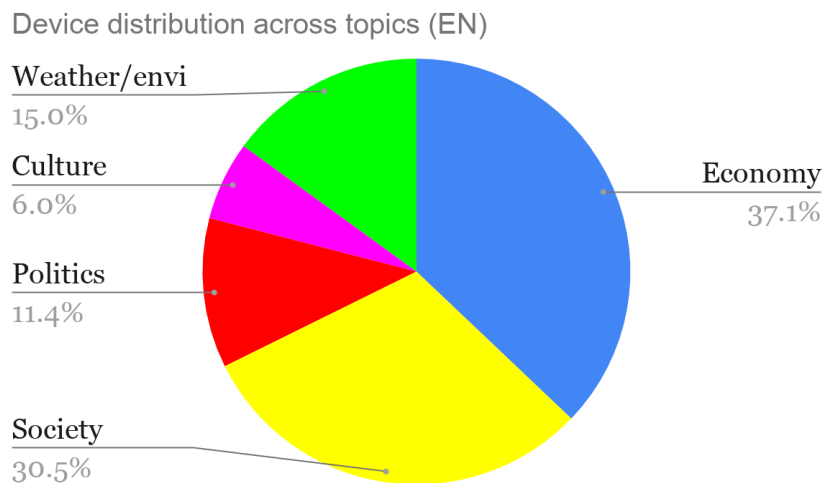
### 3.2. Analysis of the data

The total number of collected headlines in each language is 635. Of the 635 headlines, 228 (36%) were in the topic of economy, 152 (24%) - society, 101 (16%) - politics, 89 (14%) - culture, 65 (10%) - weather and environment.

In the English version, 167 stylistic devices were found in total. 62 of the 167 devices were found in the topic of economy, 51 society, 25 weather and environment, 19 politics, 10 culture.

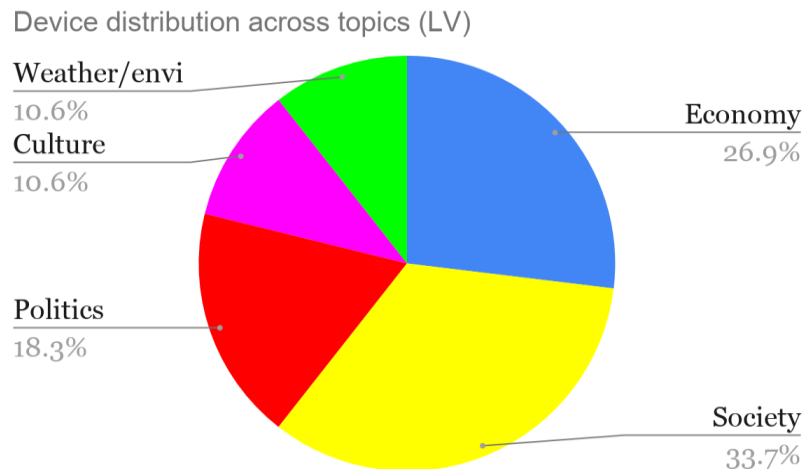


*Figure 3.3. Stylistic device distribution across news topics in the English headlines.*

As shown in the chart above, the majority of stylistic devices employed in the English headlines were found in relation to economy; topics related to society also had a relatively large number of devices in the headlines. Given that these include serious subtopics such as crime, defense, business, law, it is curious to explore what these devices involve and how they might interplay with the audience's perception (described in detail in chapters 3.2.1. to 3.2.19.) On the other hand, culture-related headlines had the smallest number of stylistic devices. This is

somewhat surprising, since culture covers art, literature, and the like: one would presume that these topics would involve artistic language.

In the Latvian version of the website, a total of 104 stylistic devices were found. 35 of those were in the society topic, 28 economy, 19 politics, 11 culture, and 11 weather.

Similarly to English, the majority of stylistic devices were found in the headlines related to economy and society; however, the Latvian version had more devices in society-related headlines, as opposed to the English version. Interestingly, the Latvian headlines prove to contain more stylistic devices. Since the medium provides mainly information regarding politics in Latvia, the higher count of devices might also point to a greater extent of evaluation or persuasion in the Latvian version of the website as compared to the English one. The content of the devices is looked at more closely in chapters 3.2.1. to 3.2.19.

The pie charts above display that the topics in which lexical and phonetic stylistic devices were found differ slightly between Latvian and English. There is a significantly larger proportion of stylistic devices related to economy in English (37.1% compared to 26.9% in Latvian). The proportion of society-related stylistic devices is similar: 30.5% in English and 33.7% in Latvian. The proportion of politics-related stylistic devices is larger in Latvian (18.3% compared to 11.4% in English). The topic of culture, in both languages, has the smallest proportion of stylistic devices (6.0% in English, 10.6% in Latvian). The topic of weather and environment shares the last place in Latvian (10.6%), whereas in English, it exceeds both culture and politics (15.0%).

Further on, stylistic devices were distinguished as per Galperin's classification. Firstly, the absolute frequency of each stylistic device in Latvian and English headlines was determined.

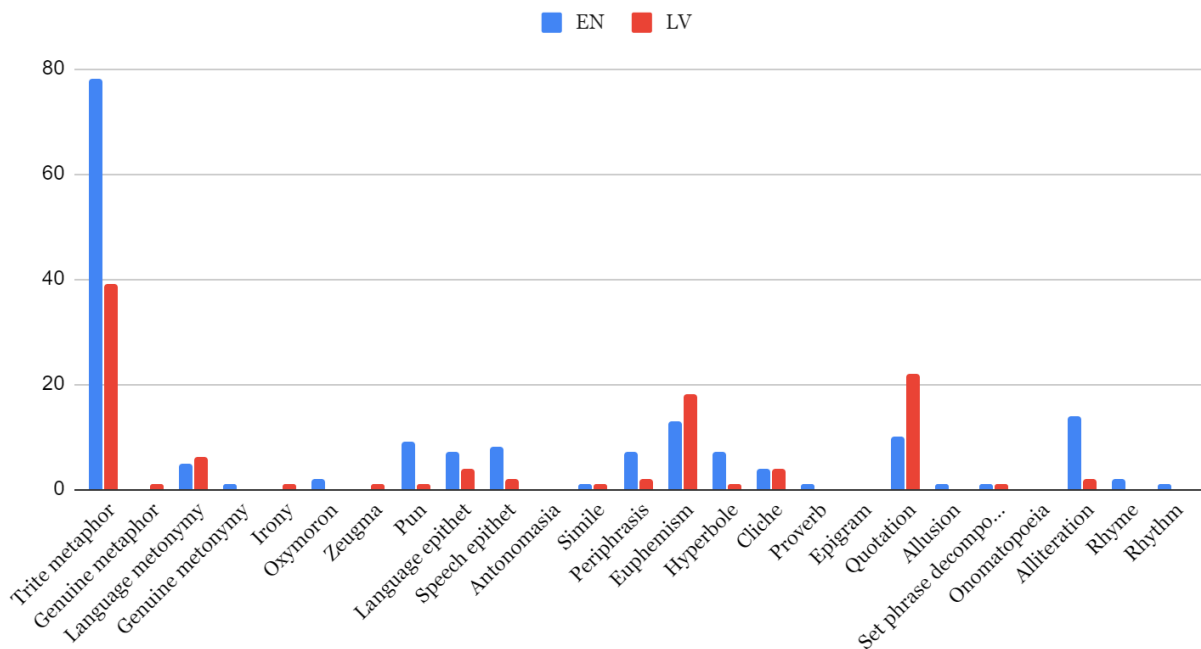


Figure 3.5. Absolute frequency of each stylistic device in *lsm.lv* English and Latvian headlines.

As seen in the table and chart above, the stylistic device most frequently found in English and Latvian was trite metaphor, 78 and 39 respectively. The difference between this and the next most frequent device is significant: in English, next comes alliteration with 14 instances, whereas in Latvian it is quotation (22 instances). Next comes euphemism (13 in English, 18 in Latvian). In English, the list continues with quotation (10), pun (9), speech epithet (8), language epithet (7), periphrasis (7), hyperbole (7), language metonymy (5), cliché (4), oxymoron (2), rhyme (2), rhythm, set phrase decomposition, allusion, proverb, simile, genuine metonymy (1 each). There

were no observed instances of genuine metaphor, irony, zeugma, antonomasia, epigram, or onomatopoeia in the English headlines of *lsm.lv*.

In Latvian, after euphemism comes language metonymy (6), language epithet (4), cliché (4), speech epithet (2), periphrasis (2), alliteration (2), genuine metaphor, irony, zeugma, pun, simile, hyperbole, set phrase decomposition (1 each). No instances of rhyme, rhythm, onomatopoeia, allusion, epigram, proverb, antonomasia, oxymoron, or genuine metonymy were found in the Latvian headlines of *lsm.lv*.

The apparent high frequency of trite metaphor in both languages suggests that the medium aims to achieve clarity and conciseness in the message, and avoid misunderstandings, as trite metaphors are well-known and embedded in the language. It can also be seen that both languages use quotation quite frequently: this points to building credibility, illustrating and reinforcing an idea. Another device found quite frequently is euphemism: softening of the message, conforming to conventional norms of politeness. These devices might serve as a means to make the medium appear unbiased, credible, impartial, which is what a public service medium should be.

Thus, headlines in both languages display frequent use of trite metaphor, quotation, and euphemism. On the contrary, onomatopoeia, epigram, and antonomasia were found in neither language. The frequency of other devices between headlines in the two languages differed. Further, each device is looked at separately.

### **3.2.1. Metaphor**

The metaphor is the most frequently used stylistic device in the analysed headlines in both languages. However, all metaphors in English and all but one in Latvian were trite. In both languages, trite metaphor is the most common stylistic device of all by a significant margin. In English, trite metaphors were found in 78 headlines. Most frequent (35) were trite metaphors in the topic of society, specifically, concerning law enforcement, legal matters, crime and defense, like *money laundering*, *watchdog*, *swoop on*, *sweeping operation*, *break contract*, *bar from entry*, *whistleblower*, *court clears way*, *cigarette mafia*, *gray list*. Also frequent (26) were metaphors denoting economic processes like business and employment, e.g., *tariff hike*, *tax hike*, *company changes hands*, *corporate wars*, *shadow economy*, *tax-dodging*, *sack*, *ditch*, *budget stumbling block*. Ten were related to weather and environment (*sunny week in store*, *cyclone tears through*, *summer to bid farewell*, *heatwave*, *road scaring away tourists*, *strawberry combats chill*). Four were found in the topic of politics (*MP cold-shouldered*, *thumbs up*, *Burovs in the frame as mayor*, *coalition lines up*.) The remaining three trite metaphors regarded culture and

history (*the dark side of Midsummer, path to independence*) and sport (*nail-biter*). No genuine metaphors were found in the English headlines.

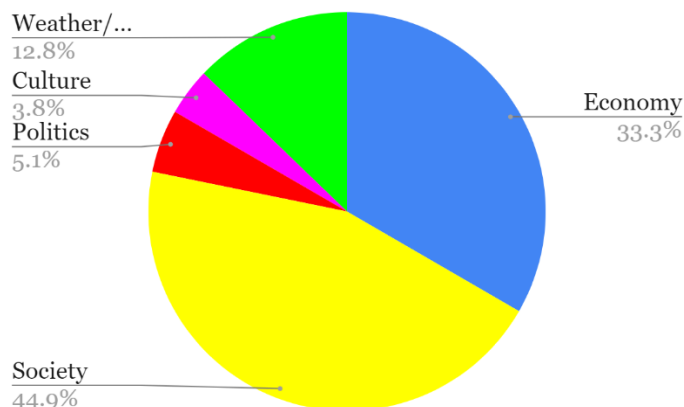


Figure 3.6. Trite metaphor distribution by topic (EN).

In Latvian, a total of 39 trite metaphors were found. Like in English, most frequent (21) were those concerning society (legal matters, crime, defense, and law): *naudas atmazgāšana, cigarešu mafija, kratīšana, melnais saraksts, pelēkais saraksts, kukuļa došana, kukuļa ņemšana, lauzt līgumu*. Again similarly to English, the second most frequent topic (9 headlines) was economy, business, employment: *alga uz papīra, ēnu ekonomika, tirgus nišas, klupšanas akmens budžetā, uz vietvaru pleciem, aplokšņu algas, uzvaras laurus plūc*. Four trite metaphors were found in weather news (*valdīs karstums, karstuma vilnis, kritīs karstuma rekordi*), three in culture (*nedēļas ietvaros, koncerts būs tils, tūristu pieplūdums*), and two in politics (*kopā ejams ceļš, kļūt pieaugušiem*).

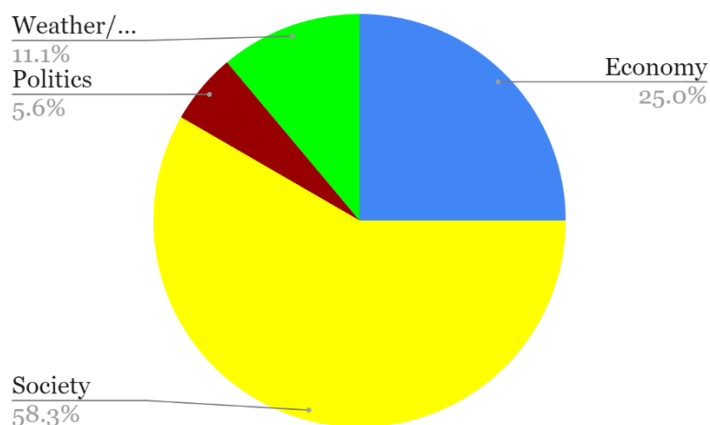


Figure 3.7. Trite metaphor distribution by topic (LV).

One genuine metaphor was found in Latvian, namely, in culture/history: *maize kļuva par izšķirošu ieroci karā*.

Comparing both languages, a few trite metaphors coincided, e.g., *money laundering*=*naudas atmazgāšana*, *cigarette mafia*=*cigarešu mafija*, *breaking contract*=*lauzt līgumu*. Trite metaphors are natural features of everyday speech; therefore, it being the most frequent stylistic device is not surprising. However, this analysis reveals that English news headlines on *lsm.lv* tend to employ this device twice as often as Latvian, which could possibly point to the fact that the English language might have more of those in general, or their use could be more common. It also reveals that both languages abound in trite metaphors regarding law enforcement, crime, business, and finance.

### 3.2.2. Metonymy

In the English version of *lsm.lv* headlines, metonymy was found in six headlines, five of which were language metonymies and one was genuine metonymy. Four language metonymies concerned business and economy: *question marks over deposit*, *Rīga plans to shut down gambling houses*, *Daugavpils joins bid*, *four-by-four purchase*. One language metonymy was in the culture context: *“Introverts” win top design award*. The single genuine metonymy was also in culture news: *Talking Latvian dogs to take over screens in Europe*, the talking dogs representing a Latvian film.

In the Latvian headlines, also six metonymies were found, all of which were language metonymies. Three concerned economy, business, and employment (*e-veselības nākotne*, *Rīga plāno ierobežot spēļu zāles*, *dzirdīgas ausis darba tirgū*); three referred to culture and sport (*maize no ASV*, *koru konkursā uzvar Dānija*, *sezonu iesāk ar sudrabu*).

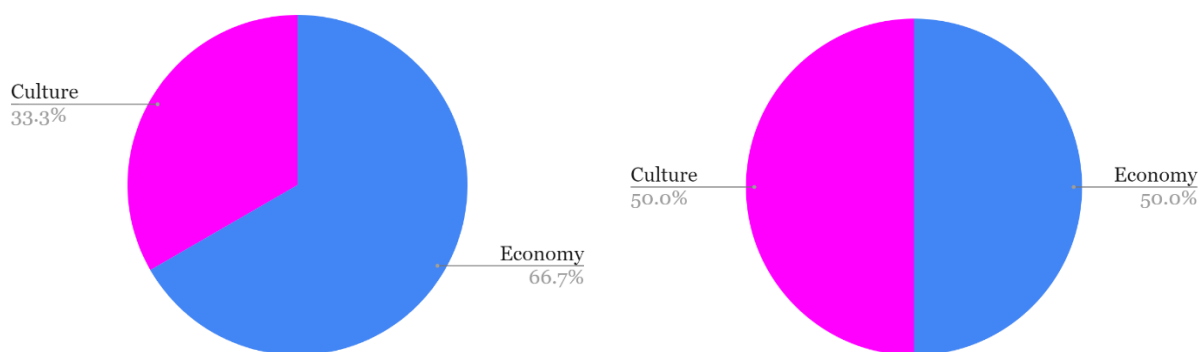


Figure 3.7. Metonymy distribution by topic (EN and LV).

Headlines in both languages contained a metonymy which used a city name to represent its authorities (*Rīga plans*=*Rīga plāno*). Others did not coincide; however, all the metonymies found could be used in both languages.

### 3.2.3. Irony

Only one instance of irony was found in the analysed headlines, and it was in the Latvian language in the topic of traffic: *Latvija ceļu satiksmes negadījumos bojāgājušo 'līderos' visā ES*. The instance of irony employs the phrase *bojāgājušo "līderos"*, which would roughly translate to *[Latvia] coming on top of the list of deaths*. Coming first, normally a positive activity, clashes with the negative notion of deaths. The device is emphasised with inverted commas.

### 3.2.4. Oxymoron

Oxymoron was found only in English. There were two instances of the device, one concerning politics (*comfortably survive*), the other - weather (*winter heat record*). Survival usually implies struggle, which comfort is the opposite of; whereas heat, surely, is normally attributed to summer rather than winter.

### 3.2.5. Zeugma

No zeugmas were found in English; in Latvian, there was one instance of zeugma: *Par dubultslepkavību Madonas novadā aizturētajam bija ieroča atļauja un alkohola problēmas*. The headline roughly translates to *The convict had/possessed a gun permit and issues with alcohol*. The sentence employs the meaning of *bija* (had) in both material and mental possession.

### 3.2.6. Pun

In the English version of *lsm.lv* headlines, nine puns were found. Six of those were in the business sector (*Latvia's ailing "e-health" system will be subject to check-up; No more EU cash for problem-plagued e-health system; Dabas dots exports juice from the "Future" to Germany; Interview: Keeping Rail Baltica on track; There's a buzz around Latvian honey in 2019; Latvian central bank abuzz about "Honey Coin"*), three were in culture and entertainment (*"Away" walks away from Annecy with international award; Foreign students digest Latvian culture in Rēzekne; Ice, Ice Jelgava*).

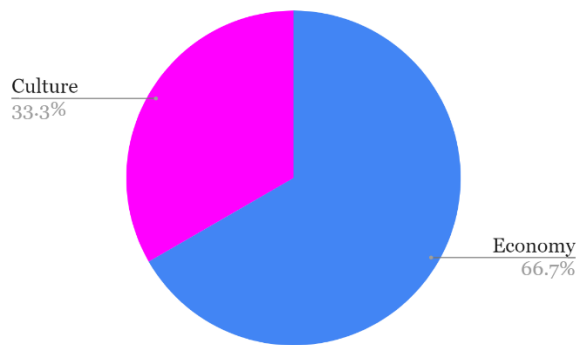


Figure 3.8. Pun distribution by topic (EN).

In Latvian, only one pun was found, regarding economy and transport: (*De*) *Rail Baltica: kāpēc Baltijas ātrvilciens skrien no sliedēm?*

The data show that in the English headlines of *lsm.lv*, pun is significantly more frequently used than in Latvian. Interestingly, in English, connections in topics can be observed: two puns refer to the state electronic health system *e-health*; two puns employed *buzz* in the meaning of *discussion, attention, talk* interplaying with the notion of honey; however, in one case, it is actual honey business, whereas in the other, it refers to a collector's coin. The pun that was found in Latvian coincides with its English counterpart, i.e. *Keeping Rail Baltica on track* and *Kāpēc Baltijas ātrvilciens skrien no sliedēm*, which translates to a train running off the tracks and refers to the project going wrong.

### 3.2.7. Epithet

In total, 15 epithets were found in the English headlines of *lsm.lv*, seven of which were language epithets and eight - speech epithets. Language epithets were found in four economy-related headlines (*busy bridge; small farmers; snail mail; sluggish growth*), one politics headline (*busy visit*), one crime-related headline (*killer drug*) and one weather news headline (*raging infernos*). Five speech epithets were found in news headlines related to economy (business, transport), e.g., *showcase market pavilion, deadliest roads, strong April, two-speed Latvia, magical mushroom coin*, two concerned health (*ailing e-health system; problem-plagued e-health system*), one was in sports (*Powerful Poles*).

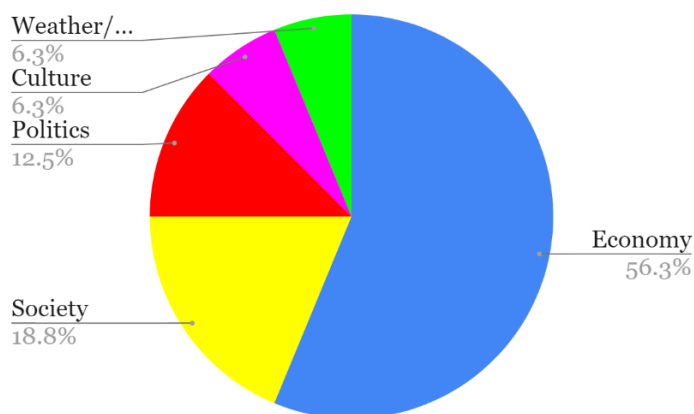


Figure 3.8. Epithet distribution by topic (EN).

Latvian headlines presented six epithets: four language and two speech. Each language epithet was in its own topic, i.e., politics (*vētrains gads*), economy (*mazie lauksaimnieki*), culture (sport and history) (*nervozā spēle, asiņainākā kauja*). One speech epithet was found in a politics headline (*divu ātrumu Latvija*), the other in transport (*ceļš - tūristu atbaidītājs*).

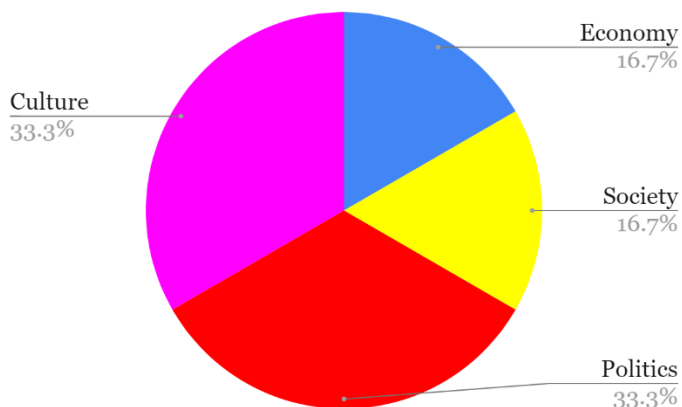


Figure 3.9. Epithet distribution by topic (LV).

Both languages shared a few transferred epithets between them, like *small farmers*=*mazie lauksaimnieki*. Evidently, not the farmers themselves are small, it is their estate, but the phrase is well-known and understood in both languages. Both languages also shared a speech epithet taken from a quote, *two-speed Latvia/divu ātrumu Latvija*. Here, it is truly an unpredictable epithet, as it is difficult to understand the meaning without context, which could prompt the reader to open the article and read on.

In English, two separate meanings of the epithet *busy* can be observed: *busy bridge*, meaning a lot of traffic, and *busy visit*, denoting a tight schedule. Interesting speech epithets concern the e-health system (*ailing* and *problem-plagued*); these are both epithets and puns, as they denote issues in the system by using health-related vocabulary.

### 3.2.8. Simile

Only one simile was found in each language; it was the same headline in the sector of environment: *forest dry as a powder keg* and *mežs ir sauss kā pulvera muca*. This simile is taken from a quote by an official and is a fairly commonly used phrase in both languages, albeit not extremely often; nevertheless, it certainly is not unique.

### 3.2.9. Periphrasis

In English, there were a total of seven periphrastic expression instances; however, all but one were in the sector of employment and virtually the same: circumlocutory phrasing standing for resigning, i.e., *stand down*, *step down*, *leave post*. The remaining periphrasis was related to the environment: *no easy task*.

In Latvian, there were two periphrastic expressions. One was found in the same environment headline (*nav viegls darbs*), the other was sports-related (*Kanādas rietumkrastā skan Latvijas himna*).

Both languages shared the expression *no easy task* or *nav viegls darbs*, a circumlocutory way of saying the task is difficult. This expression might border on euphemism, as it softens the remark.

### 3.2.10. Euphemism

English headlines contained 13 euphemisms. Five of these were related to politics (*slightly less apprehensive*; *removed from office*; *dismissing*; *restricting non-EU language TV*), five to health (*people with disabilities*; *pass away*; *drowning victims*; *fatalities*), four to economy (*infamous derelict building*; *little effect on reducing economic differences*; *failing to provide complete information*; *room for improvement*).

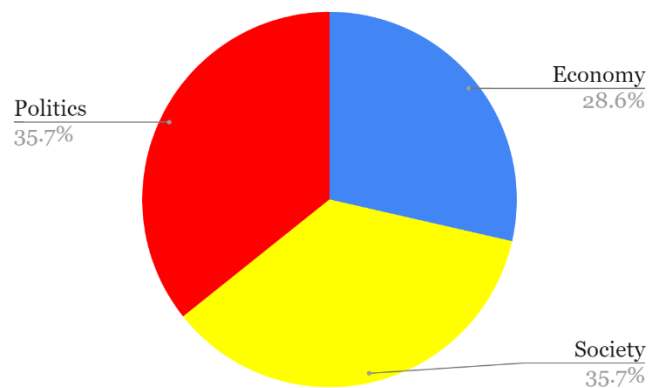


Figure 3.10. Euphemism distribution by topic (EN).

In Latvian, 18 euphemisms were found, most (11) in the health topic (*mūžībā devies/devusies; mūžībā aizsaukta; mūžībā aizgājis/aizgājusi; gājuši bojā; bojāgājušie; cilvēki ar invaliditāti*). Five euphemisms were found in politics (*pārsteizīgie paziņojumi; atstādina no amata; rosinās atstādināšanu; asa vārdu apmaiņa; ES valodās neveidotu TV programmu*), two in economy (*reforma nav mērķēta uz ekonomikas attīstību reģionos; ar neregistrētu metodi iegūti rezultāti*).

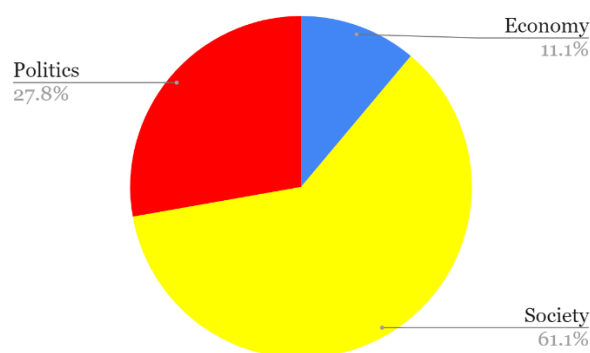


Figure 3.10. Euphemism distribution by topic (LV).

Euphemism was commonly used in the headlines of both languages. Interestingly, all were related to society, economy, or politics. Both used euphemistic expressions to denote an official being fired (*removed from office/atstādina no amata; proposes dismissing/rosina atstādināšanu*). Well-known euphemisms denoting death were also prevalent; in Latvian, however, these were more common, as all death-related headlines in Latvian used euphemisms, whereas most of the corresponding English headlines simply said “die”. An interesting case is the headline where the President proposes to restrict *non-EU language TV/ES valodās neveidotu TV programmu pārraidi*. This, without historical and cultural knowledge, does not seem to be a euphemism; however, those who are aware of the situation in Latvia immediately understand that the headline speaks of the Russian language.

### 3.2.11. Hyperbole

Hyperboles were found in seven English headlines. Four concerned crime (*massive investigation, massive distribution ring, cigarette mafia*), two were linked to environment (*storm-ravaged farms, super-strawberry*), one to economy (*profits dramatically decreased*). Latvian headlines contained only one hyperbole in the crime topic: *cigarešu mafija*.

Interestingly, although hyperboles were not too prevalent in either language, they did seem to prevail in headlines concerning crime, as if attempting to intimidate by exaggeration – or, on the contrary, downplay the situation.

### 3.2.12. Cliche

Four cliches were found in the headlines in English, three concerned weather (*summer to bid farewell, heat record falls, white Christmas*), one was in politics (*condolences offered*). In Latvian, also four cliches were present, all related to economy and business (*iekaro pircēju sirdis, aizņemties atbildīgāk, uzvaras laurus plūc, dzīvot kā Eiropā*).

The identification of cliches is a very subjective matter; plus, there are cliches in news language that differ from the cliches in everyday speech. However, going deeper into news-specific cliches would warrant an entire new research; therefore, only the cliches prevalent in everyday speech were selected. Again, identifying cliches is likely the most subjective matter of all devices in the thesis, and the list is almost certainly not exhaustible.

### 3.2.13. Proverb

In the English headlines, one proverb was present, i.e., *Heads we win, tails you lose*, presented in economy context. No proverbs were found in the Latvian headlines.

### 3.2.14. Quotation

In English, all 10 quotations came from authorities or officials apart from one in the entertainment sector, where a film was quoted (*Sling your hook!*) The nine quotations from officials were found in politics (7) and economy (2).

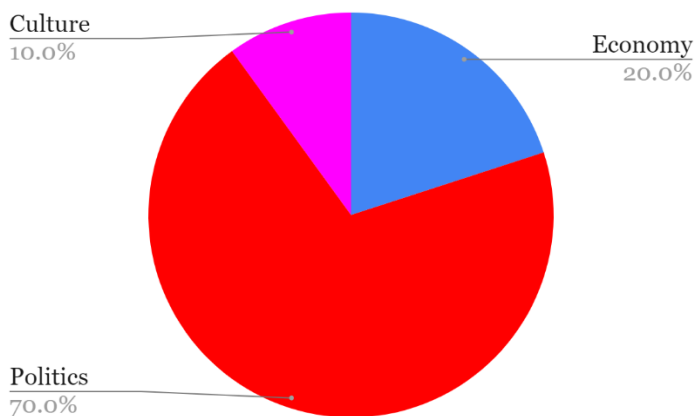


Figure 3.11. Quotation distribution by topic (EN).

In Latvian, most of the 22 quotations also came from officials' statements. Ten were politics-related, six concerned economy, two spoke of environment, one - of sports. One quote came from an "ordinary" couple, and the remaining quote was the same film quote *Sling your hook!*

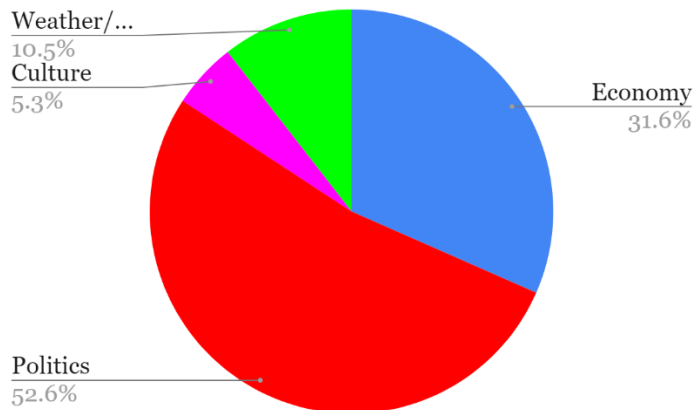


Figure 3.12. Quotation distribution by topic (LV).

There were more than twice as many quotations in the Latvian headlines as in English. This could be due to the fact that the quoted authorities spoke mostly Latvian, hence, the quote was direct and did not need to be adapted. In the English version, the quotes were mostly paraphrased instead of directly translating them.

### 3.2.15. Allusion

One allusion was present in the English headlines, in the topic of culture and entertainment: *Ice, Ice Jelgava*. No allusions were found in the Latvian headlines.

The one allusion found in English is used as an invitation to an ice sculpture festival in Jelgava city and refers to a well-known pop song, *Ice Ice Baby*.

### 3.2.16. Set phrase decomposition

English and Latvian headlines contained one set phrase decomposition each: in English, the topic concerned society and business (*Home is where the alpacas are*); in Latvian, the device came from weather news (*Cik zaļi var būt Ziemassvētki?*)

The English device comes from a proverb, *Home is where the heart is*. The news story spoke of a family business – an alpaca farm. The phrase decomposition in Latvian comes from a cliché phrase *balti Ziemassvētki* (white Christmas); however, referring to warm winters, the headline asks how *green* Christmas could be.

### 3.2.17. Alliteration

14 instances of alliteration were found in the English headlines, most (7) came from weather reports (*wet and windy weather week; warming week of weather; weather week will warm up; sunny spring week in store; cloudier and colder; weather week will be warm; weekend will be wet and windy*), three came from economy (*free firewood on offer in state forests; Latvia launches receipt lottery; Bite buys Baltcom*); two were linked to crime (*former official fined for false asset declaration; police foil alleged fake will fraud*) one to health (*Latvia, Lithuania dominate drowning deaths*) and one to sports (*Powerful Poles*).

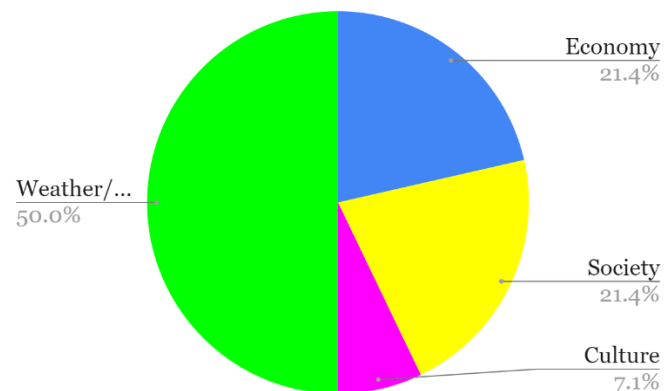


Figure 3.13. Alliteration distribution by topic (EN).

In Latvian, only two alliterations were observed, both related to economy (*Dzelzceļa «Rail Baltica» posmu caur Rīgu projektēt pieteikušies divi pretendenti; Latvijas IKP provizoriskais pieaugums pirmajā ceturksnī - 2,8%*).

The English headlines had a significantly greater frequency of alliterations than the Latvian headlines. In fact, even the two alliterations found in the Latvian headlines seem to be unintentional. The English alliterations, for the most part, seem deliberate. An interesting observation is the high number of alliterations in weather news, which are obviously intentionally selected by the author(s).

### 3.2.18. Rhyme

Two instances of rhyme were found in the English headlines: *sneak peek* (culture); *snail mail* (economy). No rhyming expressions were found in the Latvian headlines.

### 3.2.19. Rhythm

Only one instance of rhythm was found in the English weather news (*wet and windy weather week ahead*); none were found in Latvian.

### 3.3. Results

The first two research questions regarded literature review: characteristics and functions of news headlines and stylistic devices, and the relation between them.

It was found that news headlines have set peculiarities and structural compositions; the goal of the headline is to briefly inform the reader about the matter on hand and to entice the audience to read the text further. It has been claimed that stylistic devices are effective in grabbing attention of the reader. Prior studies (Galperin, 1977; Leigh, 1994; Monsefi, 2016) have shown that headlines are likely to contain metonymy, pun, set phrase decomposition, cliché, and antonomasia, although other devices may also very well be present; however, it is not common for these devices to be genuine and unique.

Other research questions regarded the empirical part of the study. The first question aimed to find out the frequency of lexical and phonetic stylistic devices in *lsm.lv* English and Latvian news headlines and compare them; the second - to determine device distribution across topics in both languages.

The study found that the absolute frequency of lexical and phonetic stylistic devices in the English news headlines is significantly greater than the Latvian headlines: 167 and 104, respectively. Given that the study comprised 635 headlines in each language, the percentage of headlines containing a stylistic device is 26.3% in English and 16.4% in Latvian. The difference of nearly 12 per cent might point to either English being richer in stylistic devices or their use being more common in English than Latvian, as well as the preferences of English and Latvian content creators on the news website *lsm.lv*.

Regarding topics, the distribution of stylistic devices differed between the two languages. In English, most devices were found in the topic of economy, followed by society, weather/environment, politics, and culture. In Latvian, society came first, followed by economy, politics, and an equal distribution between weather/environment and culture.

In both languages, the most frequently used stylistic device was trite metaphor. Since trite metaphors are embedded in the language, it is not surprising that it was the most frequent; however, in the English headlines, the frequency was nearly double that of Latvian: 78 and 40, respectively. It was found that both languages use trite metaphor frequently when it comes to legal matters, law enforcement, crime, business, and finance. The highly frequent use of trite metaphor echoes Galperin's claim that, while it is common to use stylistic devices in news

discourse, including the headline, it is unlikely that these devices be unique or genuine. While the main function of metaphor is to create associations and relations between different concepts, trite metaphors, being part of everyday language, are likely to create a sense of familiarity and could be used to avoid misunderstandings, as well as concisely illustrate the message.

Another frequent device in both languages was euphemism – 11 instances in English and 18 in Latvian. Both languages employed euphemisms regarding an official being fired, as well as when speaking of death. In Latvian, though, death-related euphemisms were more common than in English. Since the primary function of euphemism is to soften harsh topics, it only makes sense that it appears in the headlines of a public service medium, as it reaches a broad audience and should follow conventional politeness.

Quotation was also prevalent in both Latvian and English headlines. As these were mostly statements by officials or celebrities speaking Latvian, the direct quotation in Latvian was found more often (22) than in English (10). In English, the quotations were mostly paraphrased. Quotations, as stated before, can reinforce or prove a point, or illustrate an idea; in this case, a direct quote from an authority can help to build credibility, as well as minimise bias on the medium's part. Quotations, along with euphemisms, were the only devices that were more frequently observed in Latvian than in English,

Other stylistic devices appearing relatively frequently (i.e., more than once or twice) in both languages were the epithet, metonymy and cliché. The epithet appeared 15 times in English (7 language, 8 speech) and 6 times in Latvian (4 language, 2 speech). The proportions of language and speech epithets do not display a significant trend; neither do topics in which the epithets were found, as they varied greatly.

Six cases of metonymy were found in each language. It is not a large number, thus, the finding differs from the mentioned 2016 study where the metonymy was the most frequent device in news headlines. Most metonymies were language metonymies, in fact, there was only one genuine metonymy in English. This, again, echoes Galperin's statement that genuine stylistic devices are relatively uncommon in news headlines.

The cliché was found in four instances in each language. However, as stated, the perception of cliché is largely subjective; in addition, there are news clichés and headline clichés which are an entirely different category of language (different in each language, at that), and it would be impossible to take those into account within the scope of this study; it would require an entire new research.

Interestingly, other stylistic devices were relatively frequent only in English, whereas in Latvian they would only appear once or twice, or not at all. For instance, alliteration appeared 14 times in English, whereas there were only two cases in Latvian – which appeared to be accidental. Those in English, however, seemed mostly deliberate. Most alliterative devices in English were found in weather reports, suggesting that it might be the personal preference of the weather news creator. The relatively frequent appearance of alliteration in English coincides with Galperin's claims; however, it is curious that the situation in Latvian is so different.

The pun was also rather frequent (9 instances) in English – also backing up Galperin's claims that it is common in headlines. Most were found in the business sector, mainly playing with names of enterprises or projects. Again, curiously, in Latvian there was only one pun present.

English also displayed the use of periphrasis and hyperbole (7 instances each). The periphrasis, however, was nearly exclusively bound to replacing the word *resign* with a phrasal verb, such as *stand down*; it also borders on euphemism. Hyperboles, although not all that frequent, were mostly (4 instances) linked to crime. This is an interesting observation, which makes it seem as if the crime context is exaggerated on purpose – whether to intimidate or, on the contrary, downplay the situation. In Latvian, these two devices were only found once each.

Other stylistic devices appeared just once, twice, or not at all in both languages. The fact that genuine metaphor and genuine metonymy were found only once each coincides with Galperin's claim that genuine devices are rather uncommon in headlines. However, other findings contradict his statements: for instance, he stated that set phrase decomposition and onomatopoeia are very likely to be found in headlines, but this study only found two cases of the former and none of the latter.

One must take into consideration that, as stated by Leech and Short (2007: 11), not only high frequency of a device represents a pattern of interest: absence or low frequency should also be looked into.

For example, neither language showed a high number of instances of rhyme (2 English, 0 Latvian) or rhythm (1 English, 0 Latvian). This might have to do with the fact that these, in general, are more characteristic of poetry than of prose, and also that news headlines must first and foremost be concise and save space, perhaps denying room for opportunity to use these devices.

An interesting stylistic device is irony, which was found only once in a Latvian headline. The absence of this device might point to the medium *lsm.lv* attempting to position itself as unbiased and avoid highly evaluative language: as stated before, public service media should provide unbiased content. The same could be said about the near-absence of oxymoron (2 in English, 0 in Latvian).

To sum up, English *lsm.lv* headlines displayed a higher frequency of stylistic devices in total, as well as for each individual device apart from quotation and euphemism. The analysis reveals that stylistic devices employed in *lsm.lv* headlines tend to be trite or embedded in language, rather than genuine. The use of well-known devices suggests that they are used for clarity and instant effect purposes with little to no space for misunderstandings. Frequent use of euphemism and quotation helps the medium to appear credible, unbiased, and impartial, which are qualities a public service medium should possess. Frequency of devices across topics differed between the two languages. Presence or absence of certain stylistic devices create room for speculation on the specifics of headline language, as well as the purpose and aim of the medium.

## Conclusions

The goal of the paper was to determine the frequency of lexical and phonetic stylistic devices and their distribution across news topics in the English and Latvian headlines on the Latvian public media news platform *lsm.lv*.

The study found that stylistic devices were found more frequently in the English headlines of *lsm.lv* than those in Latvian by a margin of nearly 12 per cent.

The headlines on *lsm.lv* both in Latvian and English had trite metaphor as the most frequently occurring stylistic device. Both languages also had a relatively high frequency of euphemisms, quotations, epithets, metonymies, and cliches, though the difference between trite metaphor and the next most frequent device was significant. Euphemisms and quotations were the only stylistic devices which were more frequent in Latvian than in English.

The use of trite devices rather than genuine suggests that *lsm.lv* headlines use devices as a means to convey clear messages, avoid misunderstandings, and provide familiarity. Frequent use of quotations and euphemisms builds credibility and helps to appear impartial, unbiased, and conventionally polite, which are all qualities a public service medium should possess.

The English headlines displayed relatively high frequencies of pun, alliteration, periphrasis and hyperbole, whereas the Latvian headlines did not. There were few (0-2) instances of irony, oxymoron, zeugma, simile, rhyme, rhythm, proverb, set phrase decomposition, and allusion in the two languages. *Lsm.lv* headlines in neither language showed use of onomatopoeia, epigram, or antonomasia.

Topics in which stylistic devices were found differed between the two languages. In English, most devices were found under the category of economy, followed by society, weather, politics, and culture; in Latvian, the highest number of devices was present in the topic of society, followed by economy, politics, culture, and weather.

This study may be improved upon and pursued in several directions. Given that there is not a large amount of research in the field, similar analyses could be conducted in other corpora, other news websites online, to see how the Latvian and English headline style of *lsm.lv* compares with the patterns of other websites - possibly even involving a sociological research about which headlines are more compelling to the audience.

As *lsm.lv* is the only Latvian public service medium online and the only Latvian news website providing content in English, it is imperative to conduct studies on this medium to

acquire insight into its patterns, effectiveness, and possible shortcomings. The author of this study, as of the date of the research, is about to be employed by *lsm.lv*; it is therefore personally important to the author to have this analysis for possible improvements in the Latvian public media space.

The limitations of the study, apart from time and scope, concern mainly the subjective evaluation of the author. A purely objective analysis of stylistics is unattainable; therefore, the author's subjective view might have impacted the results. Moreover, the selected corpus was rather large to be manually analysed by one person; another researcher's view in this type of study could be valuable to avoid dubious cases or mistakes. Finally, the corpus might be broadened, as well as the linguistic categories which were analysed could be increased in number, e.g., involving syntactical stylistic devices.

## Theses

1. Research regarding stylistic devices in online news headlines is scarce.
2. News headlines are designed to be concise, attract the reader's attention, and impact attitudes.
3. Stylistic devices are thought to be effective in news headlines.
4. Stylistic devices are used more frequently in the English headlines of *lsm.lv* than the Latvian headlines.
5. The most frequently used stylistic device by a significant margin in the English and Latvian headlines of *lsm.lv* is trite metaphor.
6. In the Latvian and English headlines of *lsm.lv*, relatively frequent is the use of euphemism, quotation, epithet, cliché, and metonymy.
7. There is a relatively frequent use of alliteration, pun, periphrasis, and hyperbole in the English headlines of *lsm.lv*, in contrast to the Latvian headlines.
8. Latvian and English news headlines on *lsm.lv* contain little to no irony, oxymoron, zeugma, rhyme, rhythm, onomatopoeia, antonomasia, proverb, epigram, allusion, or set phrase decomposition.
9. The nature of the most frequently used devices suggests impartiality, clarity, and credibility of the public service medium *lsm.lv*.
10. The topics in which stylistic devices are frequently found differ between the Latvian and English headlines of *lsm.lv*.
11. Presence or absence of certain stylistic devices allows speculation on the language patterns, aims, and purposes of *lsm.lv* headlines in Latvian and English.
